Engineering

Construction Engineering(Duration : 1 Hour)

This workshop presents the involvement of engineering in construction with the use of new technologies in surveying, building construction and tunnelling operations for infrastructure works. the workshop also highlights the use of software application and latest information on civil engineering materials in construction.

Risk Management Plan in Construction Project(Duration: 1 Hour)

Students will be taught hands-on/practical experience, how to identify risks associated with specific projects (for example, building, highway, bridge etc.). Then, evaluate the risks based on likelihood and consequences. Following to that, develop risk response strategies and finally risk matrix.

Growth of plants using an online L system(Duration: 2 Hours)

In this workshop, students will learn how to stimulate plant growth under different conditions and circumstances by using Lindenmayer systems (L-systems)

Exercise and Its Benefits (Duration: 2 Hours)

In this workshop, students will study general exercise techniques associated with physical and biological dimensions to improve quality of life.
