

What is the Chevening Programme?

Chevening is the UK government's global scholarship programme, funded by the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) and Partner Organisations. The scholarships are awarded to outstanding individuals with leadership potential, networking skills, a study plan in the UK and a developed professional career plan, as well as a strong academic background, to pursue a one-year master's degree in any subject at any UK university.

Chevening was established in 1983 and has developed into a prestigious international scholarships and fellowships scheme. The programme operates in over 160 countries and offers highly sought opportunities for professionals to increase their academic qualifications, develop their skills, network extensively and broaden their horizons.

What is included?

- Fully-funded tuition fees (fee cap of £18,000 for MBAs);
- A living allowance at a set rate (for one individual);
- Economy class return flights to the UK;
- Costs of the UK visa:
- Access to the UK National Health Service (NHS);
- Additional grants to cover essential expenditure.

Who can apply?

- Be a Brazilian citizen;
- Have an undergraduate degree;
- Have at least two years' work experience;
- Hold and unconditional offer from at least one of three course choices;
- Meet Chevening English language requirement.

The scholarships offer a unique opportunity for future leaders to build a global network of professional relevance. Added to more than 50.000 people in the world, Brazil has over 1800 alumni who currently play outstanding roles in a variety of professional areas.

When to apply?

The application period for 2021 is between **03 September and 03 November 2020** through our website www.chevening.org/apply.
